

MALAYSIAN OSTEOPOROSIS SOCIETY - Support Grant

About the Malaysian Osteoporosis Society (MOS)

The Malaysian Osteoporosis Society (Persatuan Osteoporosis Malaysia) was formed in November 1996 with the aim of improving the care of patients with osteoporosis. Its activities include conducting educational lectures, scientific meetings, and public forums.

Aim

To support educational and public engagement projects by institutions/organisations which aim to increase the awareness of osteoporosis

Grant criteria

- This grant will only support project which promotes awareness of osteoporosis
- The grant will be awarded to the recipient(s) on behalf of the institution delivering the project. This is not an individual award
- Preference will be given to applicants who are members of the Malaysian Osteoporosis Society
- The maximum value of the award will be determined by the Malaysian Osteoporosis Society, but will not exceed RM 2,000 (two thousand ringgit) per grant
- Each application must be submitted at least 3 months before the planned event to allow adequate time for the application to be evaluated. It must use the accompanying form and include a detailed costing of how the funds will be utilised
- Applications must demonstrate that the event is able to reach a group (or audience) that MOS is unable or never been able to reach, well planned, has a publicity strategy, clear plan to raise awareness, and value for money
- The grant will not cover salary cost, purchase of equipment, maintenance of equipment, or research activities
- The grant will be split into 2 payments – an initial payment of 95% of the awarded grant, and the final payment of 5% will be released once the event report is submitted
- A report of the event must be submitted within 30 days after the event has concluded
- The decision of the MOS Executive Committee on the award of these grants is final.
